Named after Colonel Gzowski, of Toronto, A.D.C. to the Queen,
Ex-President of the Association.

*Restricted to the Active Militia of Canada. To be competed for by six Officers,
Non-Commissioned Officers or Men from any Battalion, Brigade of Field
or Garrison Artillery, or Squadron of Cavalry.*

1ST.—SKIRMISHING.

DESCRIPTION OF RIFLE—Class I. (S.)

RANGES—100 to 500 yards.

NUMBER OF ROUNDS—5 advancing, 5 retiring.

POSITION—Any, at all ranges.

ENTRANCE FEE—\$3 each Team.

First Prize, \$30 ; Second Prize, \$25 ; Third Prize \$20 ; Fourth Prize, \$15 ;
Fifth Prize, \$10. 5 Prizes. Total cash, \$100.

2ND.—VOLLEY FIRING.

DESCRIPTION OF RIFLE—Class I. (S.)

RANGES—200 and 400 yards.

NUMBER OF ROUNDS AT EACH RANGE—Five.

POSITION—200 yards, standing ; 400 yards, kneeling.

ENTRANCE FEE—\$3 each Team.

First Prize, \$30 ; Second Prize, \$25 ; Third Prize, \$20 ; Fourth Prize, \$15 ;
Fifth Prize, \$10. 5 Prizes. Total cash, \$100.

A Silver Cup, presented by Col. Gzowski, A.D.C. to the Queen (value \$200),
will be awarded to the Team making the highest aggregate in both Matches.
To remain in the possession of the winning corps for one year.

REGULATIONS FOR SKIRMISHING.

1. Sections to be under command of an officer, appointed by the Executive Committee.

2. Twenty seconds will be allowed for each round, and five points will be deducted from the score for each shot fired after that interval.

3. Competitors must not load or arrange their sights till after the word "Fire."

4. When the number of hits counted on the target exceeds the number of shots allowed in the competition, three points will be deducted for every such hit in excess of the number of such shots, unless it be proved that such hits on the target, in excess of the number of shots allowed, could only have been made by competitors in the section firing more than the authorized number of rounds, in which case that section will be disqualified.

REGULATIONS FOR VOLLEY FIRING.

Each section will fire in single rank, being commanded by the same officer the hits being registered after each round.
