wholesale and retail, to immediate necessity limits and the continued lagging shown in collections. The other side of the picture is, however, seen in the continued growth in building expenditures. March making the second consecutive gain of the first quarter, and a continued whitening down of the unfavorable balance shown in this direction as compared with a year ago, the progress made toward stable prices in the steel industry through the medium of alternate advances and decreases by the independent and the Steel Corporation, the indicated largest consumption of raw cotton in bales shown since last September, the better demand for and output of crude petroleum and gasoline, leather, shoes and automobiles and accessories, the cumulative evidence that unemployment is decreasing, the averting of a general strike in Great Britain, and last, but not least, the indications that retail stocks are not so large or so well stocked as was thought a while ago. As for some time past, most activity in distribution seems to be in the lines which, year ago first felt public abstention from buying, and there seem to be quite good reports as to the passing into consumption of cotton, woolen and silk dress goods, with repeat orders requesting prompt shipment. In fact, buying is small but often, and all the healthier because speculative purchases are practically negligible.

On the side of optimism this week may be prominently arrayed, also, the further evidence of the easing of the money and credit strain, signs of which were noted last week in the temporary easing of call money and the marking down of time rates in this direction shown this week is the dropping of Federal Reserve rediscount rates above noted.

Intermingling of poor and good news, which has been a feature of the week's advice, makes for a continued very irregular and streak trade report. Unfavorable weather, low temperatures retarding spring buying and hurting early fruits and vegetables, close to the lowest prices in the better part of a decade on the farm and depressing news regarding possible foreign and domestic labor troubles, were among the causes for the easing in securities and exchange markets, the confining of buying, both as
