June 23rd.—Preached in the morning in St. Paul's, London. Confirmed and addressed in the afternoon thirty-seven pupils of the Hellmuth Colleges, and in the evening made a Missionary Address to the Teachers and pupils of the Hellmuth Ladies College.

June 25th.—Addressed the Hellmuth College boys and distributed the "Prizes."

June 26th.—Addressed the pupils of the Hellmuth Ladies College and distributed the "Prizes."

June 29th.—Left for Petrolia.

June 30th.—Opened the Church in Petrolia; preached in the morning, afternoon and in the evening; administered the Holy Communion; ordained the Rev. Dr. Beaumont to the Priesthood; addressed and confirmed 15 candidates.

June 31st.—Returned to London.

July 7th.—Preached in the morning in Christ Church, London.

July 8th.—Attended Rectory Land Committee.

July 10th.—Left for Walpole Island to open the new Indian Church; confirmed and addressed 52 Indians, preached to a large Indian congregation.

July 11th.—Left for Windsor, spent the evening with Rural Dean Hurst.

July 13th.—Left for Ingersoll.

July 14th.—Preached here in aid of the Widows and Orphans Fund.

July 20th.—Left for Galt. Preached morning and evening in aid of the Church Society.

July 26th.—Left for Goderich.

July 27th.—Dungannon. Preached here and confirmed and addressed 41 persons.

July 28th.—Preached in the morning at Goderich, and confirmed and addressed 22 candidates.

July 28th.—Preached in Clinton in the evening; confirmed and addressed 33 persons.
