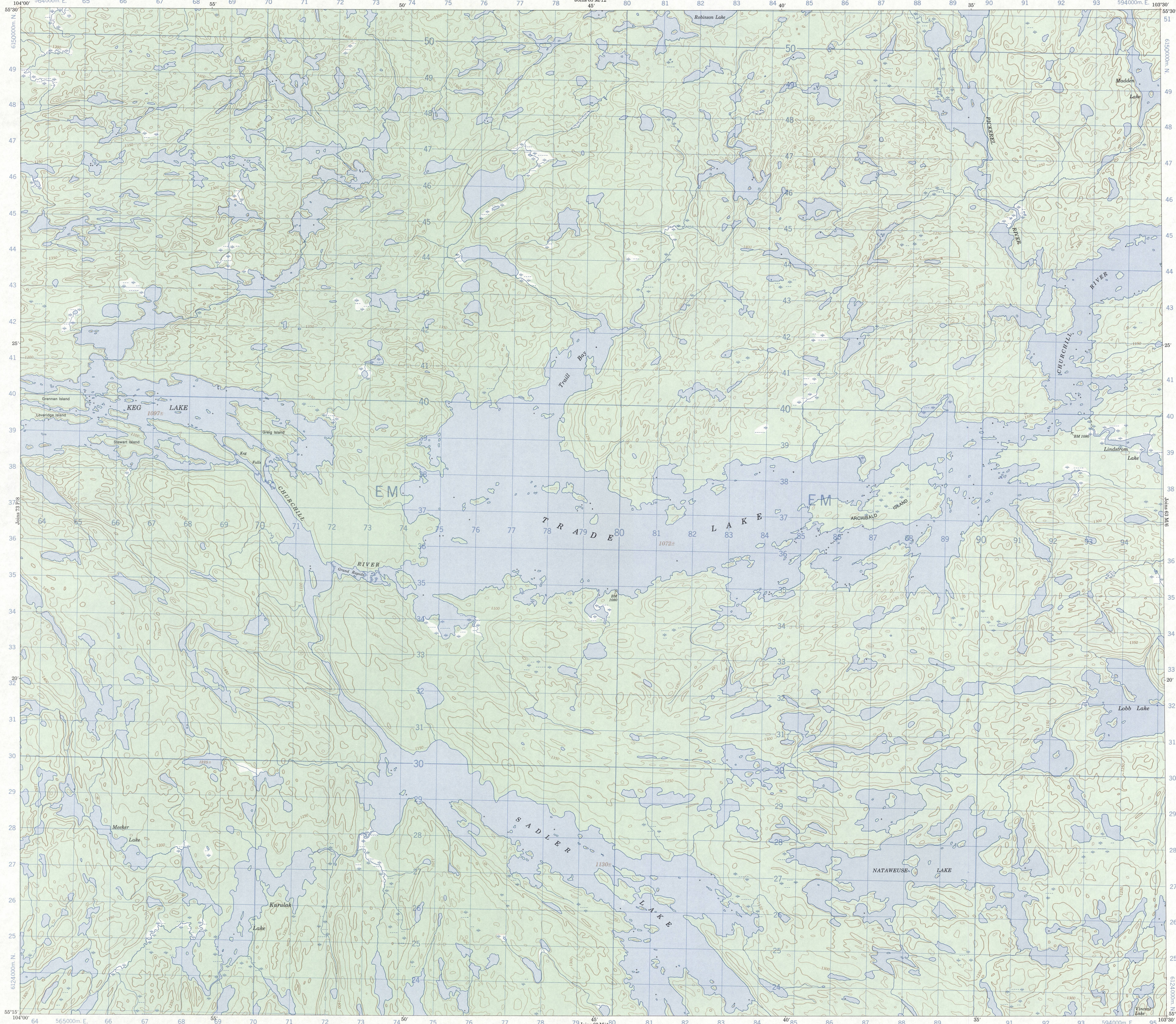
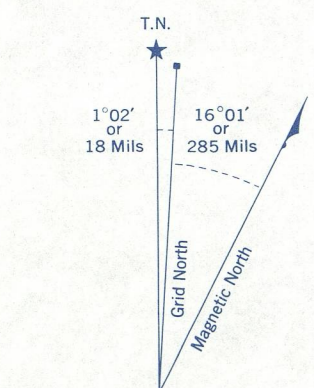

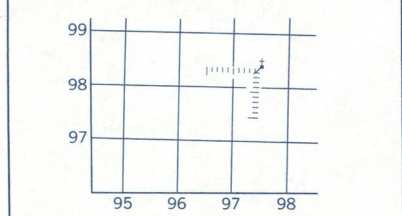

TO OBTAIN A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SAMPLE ONLY
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP



REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (as above)
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point.	97 97.5
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.	98 98.4
