

The Missionary Committee nominated yesterday was adopted by ballot.

MEMBERSHIP.

The Committee on Membership reported now and at subsequent times recommending. 1. That the Revd. W. F. Clark at his request receive a letter of dismissal. 2. That the following Ministers and Churches be received into the Union, Revds. James Howell, James Boyd, P. Shanks, J. Unsworth and Dougald McGregor—the Churches at Stanstead South, Garafraxa and Eden Mills. 3. That the following stand proposed for admission next year, Revds. A. Duff, Prof. Cleveland and J. Elliot, and the churches at Paris, Guelph, Brock, Listowel, Little Warwick and Burford. Their reports were adopted.

Devotional Exercises.

Resolved—That it be understood henceforth that all applications for admission, as well of parties who have been proposed the previous year, as of those of whom this probation is not required, be referred to the Membership Committee.

Permission was given to the subscribers of the Institute to hold their adjourned meeting at 11 o'clock to-morrow morning.

At 3 o'clock the Union took up the first question in the report of the Committee of the Union, viz: "The best means of extending the Missionary operations of the Churches, whether through the more efficient working of the Local Missionary Committees now existing, the employment of a general Missionary Agent, the engagement of Evangelists or otherwise." After extended discussion it was

Resolved—That the whole question with the resolution of the Revd. W. Clark be referred to the Missionary Committee—said resolution being "Resolved that in view of the rapid increase of population and of rising villages in our Missionary districts, this Union recommends the Missionary Society to employ one or two Evangelists in each district during the coming year, if suitable brethren can be found—the said Evangelists to be under the direction of the Local Committees, and if desirable, to secure the services of one or more students during their recess to act as Evangelists, or to enable individuals in the Committees to act as such.
