Barclay, who was secretary of state became temporary president when Charles D. B. King and Allen N. Yancy resigned as president and vice president, respectively, because of slave conditions in the West African

The question of constitutionality arose in Barclay's succession and the United States withheld recognition. An electiin held on May 5th which hos just been announced in Monrovia, resulted in the election of Barclay to a regular four-year term as president and James S. Smith as vice president.

Kennedy, employed by a local charitable organization, worked Saturday, and was informed of his good fortune by newspaper men upon his return to his humble south end lodging hiuse where he resides.
