**BILL.**

An Act to amend the Act 12 Vic., cap. 33, so that the *per diem* allowance to Members of the Legislative Assembly, shall not continue for more than one hundred days in any Session.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to limit the number of days in each Session of the Provincial Parliament, for which Members of the Legislative Assembly shall receive the allowance or indemnity fixed by the Act hereinafter mentioned: Therefore, Her Majesty, &c. : Preamble.

5 Notwithstanding any thing to the contrary in the first Section or in any other part of the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to indemnify Members of the Legislative Assembly*" Allowance under 12 V., c. 33, not to be paid for more than 100 days in any Session.  
10 "*for their expenses in attending the Sessions of the Legislature,*" the allowance or indemnity mentioned in the said Section shall not be paid for more than one hundred days in any Session of the Provincial Legislature, but shall cease at the close of the hundredth day of any Session which shall last for more than one hundred days.
