cipal Councils by the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act for abolishing the Territorial Division of Upper Canada into Districts, and for providing for temporary Unions of Counties for Judicial and other purposes, and for the future dissolutions of such Unions as the increase of wealth and population may require :*" and the said Provisional Municipal Council shall have full power and authority so soon as they shall think fit so to do, to determine the site of a New Court House and a New Gaol at Sandwich, and to purchase the property (if any) necessary therefor, and to erect the necessary buildings thereon and also to repair thoroughly or if they think proper to rebuild, the County Grammar School, and to repair, renew or erect any public buildings which they shall deem necessary for the exclusive use of the said County after its intended separation from the County of Lambton, and to raise by assessment on the assessable property real and personal in the said County of Essex, the sums necessary for the purposes aforesaid, in like manner as the Provisional Council of any Junior County may raise money for building a Court House and Gaol therein.
