

**An Act to amend the Municipal Corporations Act of Upper Canada.**

**H**ER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1.** The Council of any incorporated village may pass by-laws for raising money, by a rate to be assessed equally on the whole rateable property of the village, for the relief and support of the resident poor in the municipality. Village Councils may impose poor rates.
- 2.** The Council of any incorporated village may pass by-laws for compelling persons to remove snow, ice, and dirt from the sidewalks in front of the premises owned or occupied by them, and for removing the same at the expense of the owner or occupant in case of default; and such last mentioned by-laws may be made to apply either to the whole of such village, or to certain streets or other localities therein, as the Council may think advisable for the public benefit. May pass By-laws for the removal of snow.
- 3.** This Act shall apply only to Upper Canada. Act limited to U. C.
