diamiss the exception, the process and all things relating thereto shall be remitted to the said Inferior Court to be there heard, tried and finally determined. Provided also, that where legal objection shall be made to the Commissioners of the said Inferior Court, or either of them, every such objection shall be entered of record, and the process, suit, and demand, and all things thereto relating, shall be removed info the next Term of the Court of King's Bench of the District in which the Defendant shall be domiciliated, or in which he shall have been summoned, which shall proceed to hear and determine, in a summary manner; but if the said Court shall dismiss the objection, the process and all things relating thereto, shall be remitted to the said Inferior Court, to be there heard, tried, and finally determined.

VIII. And be it further enacted by the aurity aforesaid, that the terms of each of the said Courts shall be as follows, that is to say : from the twenty-first to the thirtieth day of January; from the twenty-first to the thirtieth day of March; from the twenty-first to the thirtieth day of June; from the twenty-first to the thirtieth day of September; and from the twenty-first to the thirtieth day of November; including the first and last days—Sundays and Fétes d'Obligation excepted.

IX. And be it further enacted be the authority aforesaid, there shall be holden at each chief place of the said Inferior Districts or circles, (arrondissemens) twice in each year, a Court of General Session of the Peace, by the Justices of the Peace for the said Inferior Districts or Circles (arrondissemens) or any three of them, one of whom shall be of the quorum, who shall hear and determine all matters which shall relate to the keeping of the Peace, and all matters of which they may take cognizance according to the Criminal Laws in force in this Province, and the terms of each of the said Courts shall be as follows, that is to say: from the first to the seventh day of February inclusively; and from the first to the seventh day of October inclusively-Sundays excepted. Pro-vided also, that no General Session of the Peace shall be holden, until a Gaol shall have been erected, at each chief place, of the said Inferior Districts or Circles, (arrondissemens).

X. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that in each of the said Courts of the
