Rule 83. — That in all unprovided cases, reference should be had, as far as practicable, to the rules and regulations or decisions of the House of Lords; and for this purpose, till further orders, the **Practical Treatise on Parliamentary Divorce**, by **JOHN McQUEEN**, Esquire, Edition of 1842, shall be deemed a sufficient authority.
