

# Golf fashions plain, cool

Plain shades and cooler more comfortable materials are dominating men's and women's golf fashions this year.

In the men's department, the solid colors in beige, blue, white, yellow and even chocolate brown and burgundy are popular. The material has swung towards cooler 100 per cent cotton and polyester/cotton fabrics rather than synthetics that

don't breathe, according to Garvey and Willmott Store Manager Jim Prentice.

With plain-colored slacks it's easier to mix and match contrasting solid colored tops or striped ones says Mr. Prentice.

In tops, the material is also cotton and polyester/cotton fabrics.

For cooler days, Mr. Prentice recommends darker colored pants, such as navy, a striped or con-

trasting top and a matching navy cardigan.

Velour cardigans, also in plain shades, or Jantzen sweaters with bell sleeves and raglan shoulders made especially with golfers in mind as they provide flexible movement, are both convenient fashions for those cooler days on the golf course.

For the golfer's headache, the downpour, polyester/cotton golf jackets are ideal, says Mr. Prentice.

Golf caps are sold at most pro shops and some men have two or three caps to coordinate with their golf outfits, he says.

"There's nothing nicer than to see a golfer step up to tee-off with everything coordinated," says Mr. Prentice. "He might not even be a great golfer but he looks like he has half the game won."

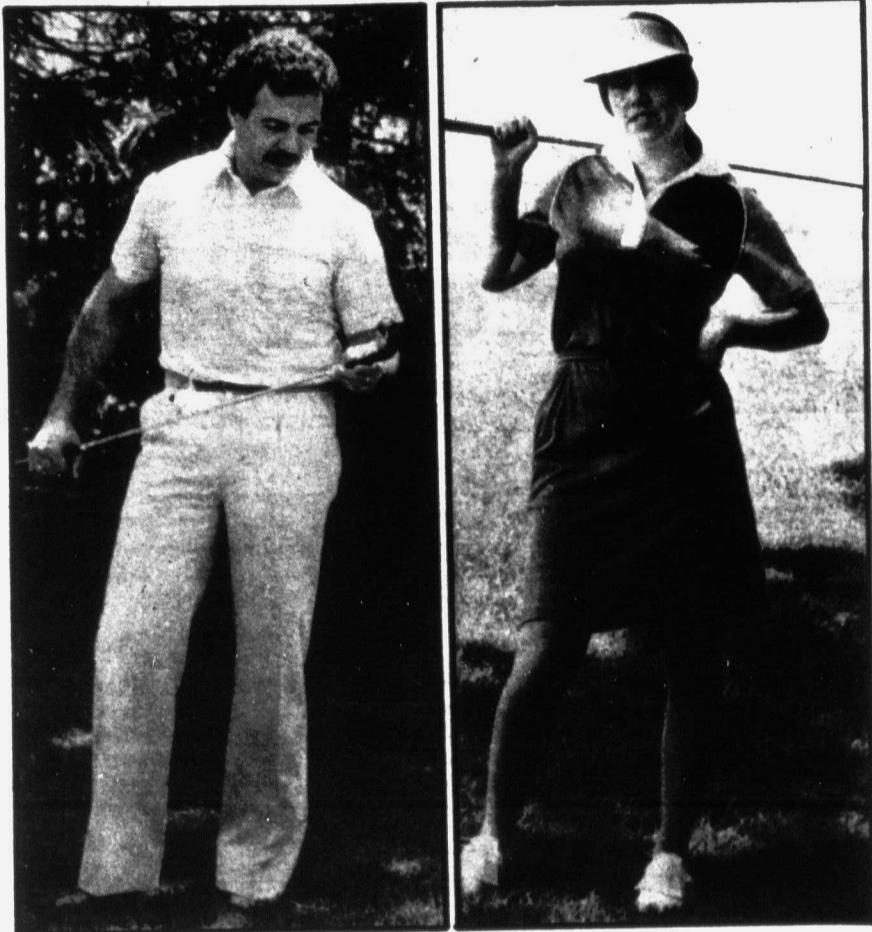
You'll see even fewer women on the golf course this year with pants or shorts as the styles are definitely swinging towards the cooler, more feminine skirt and blouse look, says Glen Abbey Assistant Professional Joe Geiser.

Skirt lengths are to the knee or slightly above and the fabrics are also the more comfortable 100 per cent cotton or polyester/cotton.

Popular styles this year are the mix and match outfits with a checkered skirt, solid colored top and matching checkered collar or the plain colored skirts and matching tops, says Mr. Geiser.

The white, round neckline T-shirts for women with the Glen Abbey logo on the front are also extremely popular for the golf course, he says.

Women's sockettes, some styles with the small pom poms on the ankle, come in white or assorted colors, and golf gloves in a variety of sizes and colors, he says.

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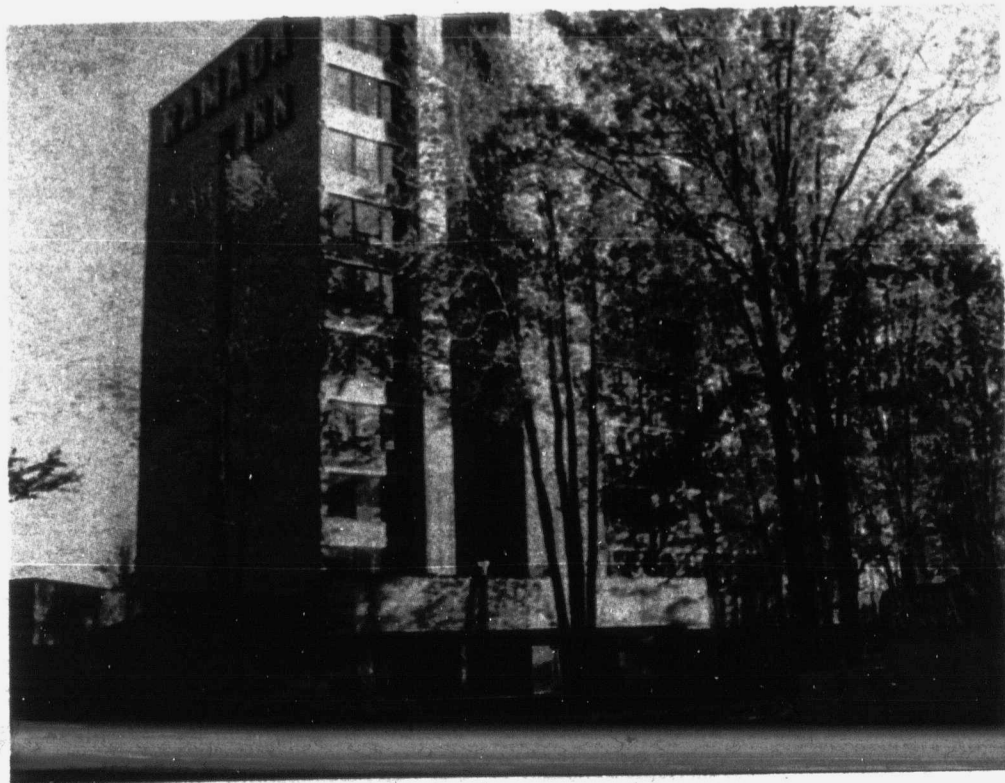
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
