Sir,-

Referring to your letter No. 24126-6 of the 27th ultimo, I enclose copies of By-Laws of the Rural Municipality of Coldwell and Lorne which adjoin Dog Creek and Swan Lake reserves, respectively. Referring to the tariff of charges incorporated in the By-Law in the Municipality of Lorne, the Agent says that this By-Law will be changed this Spring doubtless with a view to raising the charges. If the tariffs of the Lorne and Coldwell Municipalities are compared it will be noted that as they stand at the present, the schedule of charges in the contemplated regulations for the Dog Creek and Swan Lake reserves adopt a middle course, that is, the fees are higher than those of the Lorne Municipality but lower than those of the Coldwell Municipality. At first sight the charges innumeraled in your letter of the 27th ulto., appeared to be high and it is possible that some changes might be made with a view to reducing these after the Department has again taken up the matter with the Agent.
