Uplands, Ontario	24-3-41		<p>Group Captain F.S. McGill returned by air. Weather fine and mild. Snow melting very rapidly. Flying programme being carried out without interruption. Runways in much better condition. Several slight accidents occurred on runways as student pilots came in for landings. Seven Members of Parliament, D.A. McNiven, C.R. Evans, George McIllraith, W.A. Tucker, R.A. Graham, P. Tript, Don MacKenzie visited the Station and were conducted on a tour by Group Captain F.S. McGill and Flight Lieutenant R.G. Macks. During the afternoon Sir William Glasgow, High Commissioner for Australia, Mr. Budgeland his Secretary, Flight Lieutenant Rose and Flying Officer Barrie and Thorpe of the R.A.A.F. visited the Station being personally received by the C.O. At 2000 hours in the Recreation Hall a film "Poland will never Die" was shown and an address given by Mr. Victor Podoski, Consul General of Poland. He was introduced and thanked by the C.O. and his address was thoroughly enjoyed by all present. Night flying was carried out by No. 2 Squadron. Weather during morning overcast clearing around noon.
