

A P P E N D I X.PRESS COMMUNIQUE.June 9th.IMPERIAL CONFERENCE, 1937.

The Principal Delegates held their sixteenth meeting in the Prime Minister's Room at the House of Commons at 5 o'clock this afternoon, Mr. Chamberlain in the Chair.

Mr. Chamberlain read His Majesty the King's gracious reply to a message of Loyal Greetings which had been sent from the Conference on the occasion of the celebration of His Majesty's birthday.

The report of the Committee on Civil Air Communications of which Sir Archdale Parkhill was chairman was considered and referred to a Sub-Committee for further consideration of certain points.

The report of the Committee on Polar Questions was submitted by Mr. Casey, the Chairman, and approved.

The Conference was adjourned until tomorrow Thursday, June 10th, at 5 p.m.
