

Physicians and oversight of the Agents, the Accounts are not presented promptly. Whenever this has been the case, the Agent has been instructed to have the rule strictly carried out, and it is hoped that the practice of delaying Accounts will cease.

2. New Brunswick.

There has evidently been an error in paying James Barclay's Account, owing to the misleading manner in which it was made out. Mr. Barclay has been requested to refund the over-payment of \$2.⁵⁰.

The reason for adding \$4.⁵⁰ to Mr. Currie's Account was that the Department allows two miles when the distance travelled exceeds
