instances above referred to was not used Mr. Blewett should have advised the Department. These, however, could not be the cases to which you refer when you state that outfits were supplied and the Agent knew nothing about it. You will be good enough to furnish further information in reference to these matters. I may add for your information that only one account was received and that was for furniture supplied to Florence Severight.
