



I have to request you to be good enough to enquire into this request and report in full your own views in the matter. I may say that should you show that there are sufficient reasons to obtain the right application will be made to the Department of Marine and Fisheries but it is to be noted that the dues for the license will require to be paid either by the individual himself or by the band.
