I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th inst. with further reference to the appointment of a chief and councillors for the Keeseekoowenin band made on April 26, last.

In reply I beg to say that as remarked by you the Keeseekoowenin band is certainly not entitled to more than two councillors and consequently the Department must correct its letter of the 14th inst. and confirm only the appointment of McKay Flett, No. 60, and David Burns, No. 27, as councillors, these two having received a larger number of votes than the other candidates.
