



Ottawa, 13th August, 1915.

Sir,-

I beg to draw your attention to the fact that an item appeared in the Toronto "Globe" of August 5th to the effect that the lifeless body of an Indian was found on the Gardex River Reserve on the 3rd instant, and that another Indian has been arrested, it being stated that both persons were under the influence of liquor previous to the death of Sissono. It is desired that you will make full report to the Department in this matter and state what steps have been taken towards the prosecution of the person or persons who supplied the liquor to the Indians.
