SIXTH WITNESS:

I am a sapper motorcyclist of 241 Field Coy, RE, and on the afternoon of the 15th day of August I was on duty. At about 1430 hours I was proceeding on my motorbike along the Epsom Leatherhead road, towards Epsom. My bike was new so that I am sure that I was not exceeding 30 mph. Upon approaching a bend in the road I noticed two vehicles approaching me. One was large and one was small. The larger vehicle was well over on the left hand side of the road which was his correct position. The smaller vehicle was alongside of him and appeared to be overtaking. I noticed that the two vehicles were rather close together. Then the vehicles came in contact with each other. The smaller vehicle seemed to come against the offside front wheel of the larger vehicle. Both vehicles immediately moved to the left and went off the road. The smaller vehicle ended up a few yards in front. It didn't seem to me that anything very serious had occured, only the civilian driver seemed a bit shaken.
