Sir,-

Application has been received from the Provincial Deputy Minister and Public Works Engineer for right of way for a road through Malahat reserve No. 11, as shown on the enclosed blueprint, which may be retained by you.

In making this application, the Public Works Engineer states that a tentative agreement has been made with you concerning the compensation. Kindly make your recommendation to the Department of the terms to be accepted. It was noted that one of the conditions was payment of a lump sum of \$900.00 as compensation for the land required and improvements affected. As there are certain individual Indian improvements affected, it will of course be necessary for the Department to have itemized information concerning the amount of compensation due to each Indian on account of damage to the individual improvements, in accordance with Sec. 72 of the General Instructions to Indian Agents.
