

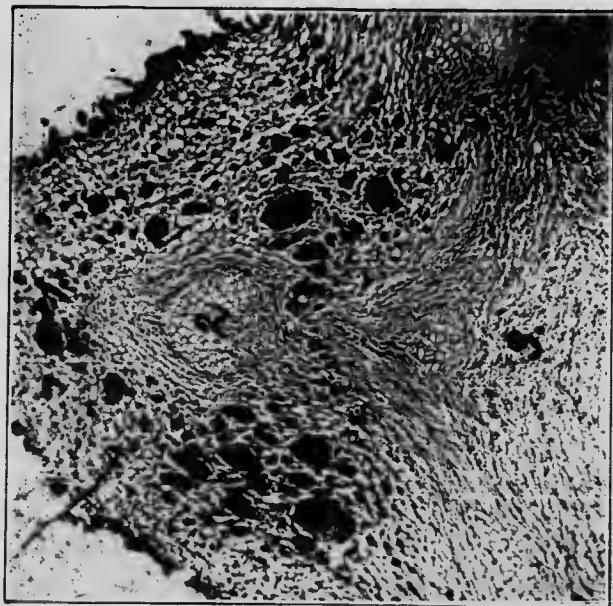


Fig. 11. Cross section of diseased pedicel of young apple. 1, bark; 2, vascular bundle; 3, wood. The darkened areas in the bark are cells surcharged with *B. amylovorus*. Section 4 microns thick, stained carbol fuchsin. X about 50.

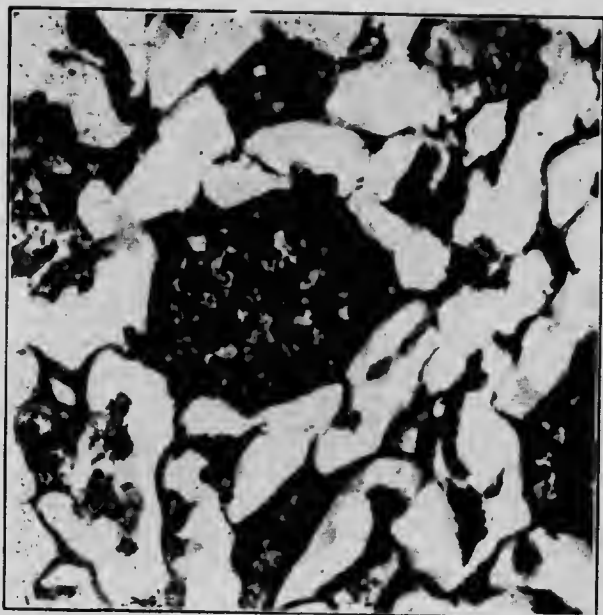


Fig. 12. Cross section of bark of diseased apple pedicel (same section as Fig. 11), showing cells filled with bacteria within a gummy matrix. X 1000.
