

The House accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee; and after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; and the Honorable Mr. *Cameron* reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and made amendments thereunto.

Ordered, That the Report be now received.

The Honorable Mr. *Cameron* reported the Bill accordingly; and the amendments were read, and agreed to.

Mr. *McKellar* moved, seconded by Mr. *Mackenzie*, and the Question being proposed, That the Bill do pass;

Mr. *Magill* moved, in amendment, seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Carling*, That all the words after "Bill" to the end of the Question be left out, and the words, "be re-committed to a Committee of the whole House to amend section 76, so as to make the qualification of Electors in Cities \$500 real property, instead of \$600, as reported by the "Committee," inserted instead thereof;

And the Question being put on the amendment; the House divided: and the names being called for, they were taken down, as follow:—

So it passed in the Negative.

And the Question being again proposed, That the Bill do pass;

Mr. *Magill* moved, in amendment, seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Carling*, That all the words after "Bill" to the end of the Question, be left out, and the words "be re-committed to a Committee of the whole House, to amend section 402, so that Councils of Cities "shall have power to fix the salaries of the various members of the Police Force in such "Cities," inserted instead thereof;

And the Question being put on the amendment; the House divided:—And it passed in the Negative.

And the Question being again proposed, That the Bill do pass;

Mr. *Magill* moved, in amendment, seconded by Mr. *Chambers*, That all the words after "Bill" to the end of the Question, be left out, and the words, "be re-committed to a "Committee of the whole House, to amend section 66, so that the Council of every City "shall consist of the Mayor, who shall be head thereof, and who shall be chosen by the "qualified Electors of each City, and three Aldermen for each Ward, in every such City," inserted instead thereof;

And the Question being put on the amendment; the House divided: and the names being called for, they were taken down, as follow:—
