

Very Latest War News.

Gen. Lee, the invincible Southern, is not dead, but wounded even—although the North has been told that he was both at least twenty times during the past week—and has not retreated. Heavily wounded and has not been seen since the late afternoon, calmly waiting for the foe. There was heavy shelling on Friday. At 6 p. m. on the 14th, Lee was on the right bank of the river in front of Spotsylvania instead of in the rear. What does that mean, if not that he has stopped Grant's drive to Richmond? He must be retreating? The state of things now revealed is most astounding after the volumes of loud-mouthed bragadocio that have been telegraphed North about the glorious successes won by the Federal, and the disgraceful flight of the intermeddlers of the South!

The deatude of blood proached and moved for by General Henry Wood Beecher has been proven out; something like 60,000 men have been killed and wounded on the Federal side, and what is the result so far? Nothing has been gained! Grant may soon be forced to retire, and we may perhaps be informed within the next month that "Washington is considered safe."

American Gold is advancing! The news from Europe is quite warlike. The Channel fleet has been ordered from Portland to the Downs. An "unofficial" report is that the British fleet is on the move.

Small Farms Better than Large Farms. Another couplet—this is a triplet, has as much good sense in it as the one on which we discussed last week: A little wife well willed, A little house well filled, A little farm well tilled.

The great mistake which our farmers make, East and West both, is in undertaking to cultivate too much land. It seems that the more land a man has, the more he wants. When Farmer Dobson was charged with this covetousness he denied it, and said that he wanted only the land that joined on his farm. But when he got that, he found that more joined on, and more yet, and he was likely to be satisfied. He reached the sea shore. His farm would then be the whole continent.

From time to time we publish the results of farming on a moderate scale, and they are always sufficient to show that it pays much better to spend the money and labor on a small farm, and get the most of it, than to work a wider area, and leave it half done.

The principle is the same in almost every kind of business. Anything which is done in a haphazard way, and the great profit in doing it, is to be found in making the best possible use of what is at hand, and a man works at a trade, it will be found, in the long run, that it will pay better to make a good article than to turn out a greater amount of inferior work. We advised a farmer, last week, if he used a sewing machine in his work "No," said he; "but if you use it in your house, it will pay for itself."

Some men, with a large capital, can manage a great farm and make it profitable, and at the same time, they can manage themselves over more surface than they can cover to advantage. They find, in their own case, that it is not the amount of work on the land that pays. And this is just the kind of lesson a farmer will learn. And so it comes to pass that many a man, through the life he will live, will be a failure in the end, and die worth little or nothing more than he was when he began, and all his trouble springs from the fact that he has been trying to do too much, to manage too much land, and has found, by experience, that a "little land well tilled" would have brought more money and more credit.

STREET DEATH—SAD CASE.—An inquest was held on the 6th and adjourned till the 14th inst. The body of a young woman named Mary Jane Foster, and child, at the house of Mr. Samuel Robinson, in this township. It appears that the woman had come up from the hospital in Toronto, and gone into service with Mr. Robinson, and had become acquainted with some man in the neighborhood. She was a cripple, having had both legs amputated. She was pregnant, but had refused to accept of the best medical treatment. There were 18 witnesses examined in the case. Verdict—"That the deceased came to her death in child bed, and that her death was caused by her determination to conceal the birth of her child."
