NEW KIND OF FUEL.
Moline, Ill., Dec. 14.—Charles W. Smith, of Minneapolis, has just secured a patent on a process for converting soft coal into a fuel which is pronounced superior to any anthracite. It is claimed that a ton of soft coal produces 1
