channel of the Nile and left the plateau a desert. In all probability the rock whereon Enoch founded the Pyramid was not more than thirty feet above the level of the river at the time of building.

3. The "cubit" used in Enoch's measurements was evidently the ancient sacred cubit, equal to twenty-five of our modern inches and a small fraction more.

With boundless gratitude I acknowledge my indebtedness to many learned writers on Egypt and the Pyramid, and to the venerable Hebrew Talmudists.
