SCRAMBLED EGGS.—Beat up two eggs, and mix with a teacupful of milk—season with pepper and salt. Put into a saucepan in which a little butter has been melted. Sitr all well together over a moderate fire till set, then turn out either on toast or on a hot dish, and serve at once.

MUTTON BROIH.—One pound of mutton or lamb cut small, one quart of cold water, one tablespoonful of rice or barley, four tablespoonful of milk, salt, pepper, parsley; boil the meat without the salt, closely covered, until very tender; strain it and add the barley or rice, Simmer for half an hour, stirring often; add the seasoning and milk, and simmer for five minutes more.

CHICKEN SALAD .- Take equal parts of CHICKEN SALAD.—Take equal parts of chicken and celery, or hait as much chicken as celery. Cut the chicken in quarter inch alices. Scrape, wash, and cut the celery in slices. Mix with French dressing and keep on the ice till ready to serve. Make a mayonaise dressing and mix part of it with the chicken. AN ECONOMICAL CUSTARD.-Boil one AN ECONOMICAL CUSTARD.—Boil one pint of new milk in an enamelled saucepan, with a quarter of a candied lemon rind cut in strips, two bay leaves, and sugar to taste. Meanwhile, rub down smooth a desert spoonful of rice flour into a cup of cold milk, and mix with it the eggs well beaten. Take about half of the hot milk and mix with the cold milk and eggs, then pour it back into the saucepan, and stir it one way till it thickens and is on the point of boiling. Next pour it out into a jue, or other vessel, stir it pour it out into a jug, or other vessel, stir it for some time, adding a tablespoonful of peach water, and any flavouring you please.

APPLE JELLY.—Take five pounds of cooking appler, sub them clean with a cloth, and cope and cut them down into cold water, but do not peel them. Havetwo quarts of water boiling in your jelly pan, and into this put the cut apples, after straining them from the cold water; boil now till the pulp through a wire colander, and again through a flannel jelly bag, and to each pound of juice add ten ounces of sugar, and boil for twen y minutes after it comes to the boil. Before dishing add a pennyworth of essence of lemon and a little saffron or cochineal; gum up while hot, and keep in a cool, dry place.
