for the benefit of the right party, or they may be disposed of in such other manner as provided for by the internal regulations of the country concerned.

Article 14

Parcels exchanged between the two countries may be insured in accordance with the terms set forth in the Annex of this Agreement.

ARTICLE 15

The details necessary for the execution of this Agreement shall be settled by mutual consent between the Administrations.

ARTICLE 16

1. This Agreement shall supersede and abrogate the Parcel Post Agreement between Japan and Canada signed at Tokyo on February 16, 1956 and at Ottawa on March 20, 1956, including its Annex.

2. This Agreement shall be approved by each Contracting Party in accordance with its constitutional procedures, and, thereafter, it shall enter into force on the date to be agreed upon by the Contracting Parties in an exchange of diplomatic notes.

3. This Agreement shall continue in force until the expiration of six months after either of the Contracting Parties shall have notified the other of its intention to terminate it.
