Foreign Affairs Minister Bill Graham will participate in discussions on international justice issues with a group of young Canadians on March 1, 2002, as part of a three-day youth forum. Minister Graham will address the group and answer questions. Media representatives are invited to attend.

Take The Stand: Youth Forum on International Criminal Justice takes place from March 1 to 3, 2002. The event is being organized by War Child Canada and is funded by the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade. The forum will focus specifically on the imminent establishment of the International Criminal Court and other efforts to promote accountability for genocide, crimes against humanity and war crimes. Fifty youth from across Canada, between the ages of 16 and 25, will participate in the forum. Participants were chosen by War Child Canada from hundreds of applicants, based on the originality of their responses to an on-line questionnaire about international justice issues.
