A third alternative is already underway – that of convening a geographically and experientially diverse group of experts, governmental and non-governmental alike, under the auspices of a respected NGO^{45} , to explore the issue with a view to enlarging the common understanding of the international community in relation to international legal prohibitions on arms transfers.
