VISIT OF DR. HILDEGARD HAMM-BRUECHER (FRG)

Dr. Hamm-Bruecher, Minister of State responsible for cultural affairs in the Foreign Office of the Federal Republic of Germany, is visiting Canada May 27-31 to head the German delegation at bilateral cultural consultations taking place in Ottawa May 30 and 31. These consultations take place from time to time under the Canada-FRG Cultural Cooperation Agreement of 1975 to review accomplishments and discuss future programs. The Canadian delegation will be headed by Maurice Dupras, M.P., Parliamentary Secretary to the Secretary of State for External Affairs, and will include provincial representatives.

During her visit to Ottawa, Dr. Hamm-Bruecher will sign a Canada-FRG Film Relations Agreement on May 30, with Secretary of State the Hon. John Roberts signing on behalf of Canada. She will also call on a number of ministers and heads of cultural organizations. Before arriving in Ottawa, Dr. Hamm-Bruecher will have addressed a session of the conference of the Learned Societies of Canada in London on May 28 on multilateral cooperation in education. Dr. Hamm-Bruecher was the co-author of a 1975 CECD report on the Canadian education system.
