## B—Penitentiaries—

161. Administration of the office of the commissioner of penitentiaries including \$90,000 for grants to recognized prisoners' aid societies, as may be approved by the treasury board, \$641,516.

162. Operation and maintenance of penitentiaries including compensation to discharged inmates permanently disabled while in penitentiaries, \$14,878,797.

163. Construction, improvements and equipment, \$2,353,840.

523. Administration of the office of the commissioner of penitentiaries, including authority for a special adviser to the Minister of Justice on correctional planning, having the rank and status of a deputy head of a department, and one additional deputy commissioner of penitentiaries to be known as the senior deputy commissioner, having the power and authority of the senior deputy commissioner under the Penitentiary Act; to be appointed by the governor in council to hold office during pleasure and to be paid such salary as may be fixed by the governor in council—further amount required, \$17,792.

524. Operation and maintenance of penitentiaries—further amount required, \$69,340.

525. Construction, improvements and equipment—further amount required, \$632,250.
