In compliance with the Act respecting Vaccination in the Province of Ontario and for protection of the public, the Board of Health for the Township of Darlington has decided that all children and other unvaccinated persons shall attend before a duly qualified medical practitioner for Vaccination.

For convenience of the public DR. J. C. MITCHELL, Medical Health Officer will attend at the following places at the hour of TWO O'CLOCK P. M. on the days mentioned for such purpose :

The Medical fee has been placed at 25 cents, which must be paid at the time by the parties Vaccinated. Persons unable to pay can arrange with the attending M. D. to have the expense paid by the Municipality.
