

90.— Being in Column of Squads, to March to the Left (or Right) in Column of Sections.

*Column of Sections to the—Left (or Right).—*On the word LEFT (or RIGHT), the leading section commander will give the command. . . . "section, squads left (or right)." On the word LEFT (or RIGHT), the leading section executes squads left (or right) and continues the march in the new direction. Each succeeding section executes the same movement on the same ground by order of its section commander and covers its leading section.

91.— Being in Column of Squads, to March to the Left (or Right) in Column of Half Preceptor's.

Column of Half Preceptor's to the—Left (or Right).—On the word LEFT (or RIGHT), the senior subaltern will give the command, "right half Preceptory squads left (or right)." On the word LEFT (or RIGHT), the right half Preceptory executes squads left (or right) and continues the march in the new direction. The left half Preceptory executes the same movement on the same ground by order of the junior subaltern and covers the right half Preceptory.

92.— Being in Column of Squads, to March to the Left (or Right) in Line of Squads in Column of Files.

Preceptory Left (or Right)—Turn.—On the word TURN, all turn to the left (or right) and move on in file.

93.— Being in Column of Squads, to March to the Left (or Right) in Line of Squads in Columns of Threes.

By Squads Column of Threes to the Left (or Right), Threes—Left (or Right).—On the word LEFT (or RIGHT), all execute threes left (or right).
