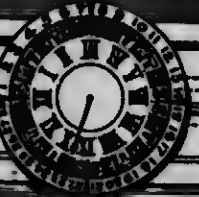


QUESTIONS TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS

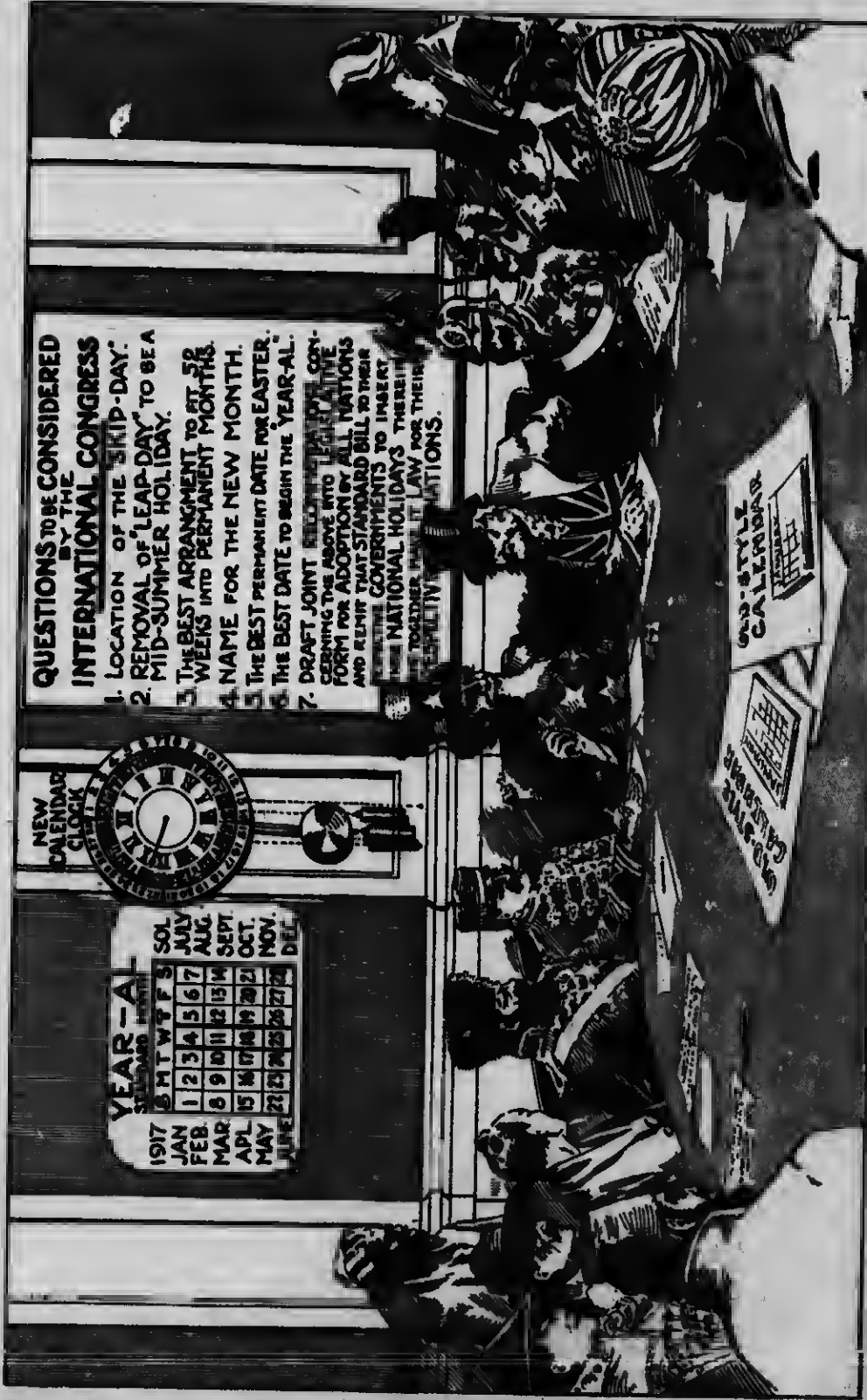
NEW CALENDAR CLOCK
