

TWO TROOP TRAINS ARRIVE TODAY

C.P.R. Arranges to See Men
Reach City in Record
Time.

The second troop train from the S. S. Olympic, containing the men for this district, left Quebec at 1 p.m. yesterday on C.P.R. special No. 419. There are 366 men for Toronto and 202 for out-of-town places.

With a good run, the second troop train, containing 468 men, will probably arrive at North Toronto station about noon today. 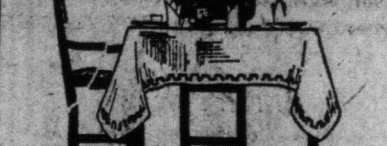
