an attack. Two thousand soldiers guard the entrance, 12 miles from the city, and four old cannons have been mounted on an island in the harbor. People are starving. Salt pork costs a dollar and a half a pound; ice, 50 cents. The Spanish commander told the starving citizens to go into the country, as he could not feed them. Many soldiers are joining the insurgents to get food. The conditions at Puerto Principe are worse. A column of five thousand Spaniards started for Moron, carrying flags of truce.

When fired upon by the insurgents the commander sent word that he was no longer making war upon Cubans, but was going to the coast to fight Americans.

Gen. Lozoya Recrea replied: "Spain cannot fight the United States without fighting us. Their war is our war."

The Spaniards lost 900 men in the Pacificos, spongers and fishermen are being pressed into the Spanish service. The Spanish columns on the way to the coast are burning all the country homes.

President Maso has ordered Generals Gomez and Garcia to meet himself and cabinet at Moron trocha, where there will be a concentration of Cuban forces.
