EUROPEAN CROPS

PROGRESS BADLY

Franco-Italian Conditions Continue Unfavorable for Good Yield.

WHEAT PRICES FIRM

Liverpool Market Continues to Be Influenced by Shipping Scarcity.

Special to The Toronto World.

New York, Feb. 14.—Broomhall sent the following cable from Liverpool today:

"Wheat was dull but firm, with buyers waiting. Shipping is difficult and this restricts business. Flour was firm, with supplies moderate. American shipments are increasing. Absorption by the continent is liberal. Corn was firm, with arrivals limited and consumption liberal. Clearances from Argentina are light and American offers firm. Oats were dull but steady. Barley and rye were strong, with supplies light and world's shipments decreasing. There is an active enquiry for spot land, but futures are easy on profit-taking, due to a belief that the short interest has been largely covered. Arrivals are fair.

"The weather in Argentina is clear and warm. Corn prospects show some improvement in the south, but elsewhere they are unfavorable. Wheat at Buenos Aires showed a 1/2c to 3/4c lower, and corn 1/2c down.

"Beneficial rains have fallen in India, where crop prospects generally are favorable, but dryness is reported over a wide area. Holders are reserved, and actual clearances light owing to scarcity of tonnage. Rates are high.

"The agricultural outlook in France is not favorable, the weather news has been again very gloomy and demands for foreign arrivals are increasing, but purchases for distant delivery are hard to accomplish. The situation in Russia, which is still very cold in Russia, with only light snow covering over an important area. Native consumption is large. Therefore stocks and supplies are rapidly notwithstanding light exports.

"Crop prospects in the Balkan states are negligible as planting was delayed by military invasion. Good seed was scarce. The weather has been unfavorable, wet, followed by heavy snow. The situation in Australia is being wet and cold, with little prospect. Native supplies are moderate. And action is further given that after such last mentioned date the said Administrator will proceed to distribute the assets of the estate of which notice shall not have been received by her at the time of the expiry of the notice. SLOW AND DRAGGY

Cows and Bulls Firm at Prices Steady With Monday.

CALVES WERE FIRM

Good Stuff Market Was Good—Some Hogs Sold Ten Cents Higher.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards yesterday consisted of 79 calves, 337 calves, 2188 hogs and 160 sheep and lambs.

Trade was slow and drab, with the Union Stock Yards yesterday, with prices fairly steady at Tuesday's figures. In a few cases, butcher cattle were even lower in price, but as we said yesterday, the choice western market is anything but good, and are selling for far more than they are worth. There was no change in the price of cows and bulls.

Stockers and feeders were a little slow, good choice selling at a steady price, but common animals were 25c lower. Milkers and springers were steady at prices the same as on Tuesday.

The calf market was firm, without any change in price. Sheep and lambs were steady at \$14.00 to \$15.00.

Hogs—Packers held to their quotations, having \$14.00 to \$15.00 for 100 lb. steers and heavier, several loads of hogs that sold at \$14.50, fed, and \$14.75, weighed off cars.
