Rev. Mr. Ritson Explains His Mission to the Northwest.

The luncheon extended by the city ministers at Webb's yesterday afternoon was an opportunity of meeting Rev. J. H. Ritson, M.A., secretary of the British and Foreign Bible Society, who is on his way to the Northwest. He is accompanied by Rev. E. S. Bampton, an underwriter at Lloyd's, and a brother of the deputy-chairman of the Bible Society committee of London, Eng.

Increased Expenditure.

The estimates for the year were presented at the annual meeting of the Metropolitan Board of Works yesterday. There is an increase in expenditure for benefits of \$338,877 over those of last year. This year there are 278 ministers and 46 children to be provided for. Last year there were 269 ministers, 223 widows and 47 children. The average sum given this year to ministers was \$282, as compared with \$247 last year. The treasurer reports aggregate receipts for 1904-05 of \$132,700. The business of the day was mainly of a routine nature. Among the members present were: Rev. Dr. Carman, in the chair; Rev. W. S. Griffith, and Edward Gurney, treasurers; Rev. J. P. Picher, Rev. W. Kettlewell, Rev. Dr. Langford, Dr. J. B. Willmott, D.D.S., M.D., Rev. J. Woodworth, D.D., and T. Hilliard.

1000 Go West.

They are people who intend living permanently in the west, and come from all parts of Ontario. Many of the cars on the three big excursion trains were filled with baggage and household effects of hundreds of families. The lobby of the station was filled all morning as the crowds waited for their various trains. There will be more excursions imminently in the fortnight.

THIS ELECTRIC VOTING CHARGES ARE RECKONED

North Norfolk Conservatives Have 685 Charges, Naming Several Prominent Politicians.

North Norfolk Conservatives presented a record-breaking bill of particulars at Osogood Hall yesterday in connection with the protest against Arch. Little, M.L.A. There are 685 separate and distinct charges, and one-third mentioned in the recital are Speaker Charlton, Hon. Richard Harcourt, John Charlton, M.P., W. M. German, M.P., George H. Watson, K.C., Hugh Hamlin and others. The bill is a list of 685 charges in the giving of money to electors for that purpose. The North Norfolk Association and the North Norfolk Liberal Association, together with Hal Donley, publisher, are named in the bill. The first charge is tantamount to a conspiracy to bribe, to adduct and to deprive voters and Speaker W. A. Charlton in mentioned with Donley, Werrett, Barrister W. B. Wilkinson of Waterford and other electors. They are claimed to have agreed on a plan of bribery and other illegal acts by distributing money to buy votes and inducing a number of hotels, including the Beemer House, Waterford, Queen Hotel, Simons and hotelier Windham Centre and La Salette, to sell liquor during prohibited hours. Werrett is charged with giving protection from prosecution to the hoteliers, while it is further charged that voters were to be made drunk and packed up in rooms, abducted or deported, to be prevented from voting.
