### Giant Puzzles the Military

The military authorities in Wiltshire, Eng., find themselves faced by a problem in the person of a young innkeeper who is said to be 8 feet 2 1/2 inches in height and to be still growing. The man, who is 22 years of age, weighs considerably over 280 pounds, a penny can be dropped through his finger-ring, and when he takes a railway journey he has to travel in the guard's van. His size in boots is said to be 22 1/2. As the military authorities do not know what to do with him, he remains for the present at his inn. Many giants have been described during recent years and the condition of gigantism has aroused widespread interest in medical circles. Patrick Colter, an Irishman, who died at Clifton, Bristol, in 1802, was 8 feet 7 inches in height. The famous "Irish giant" O'Brien (Charles Byrne), whose skeleton is now in the museum of the Royal College of Surgeons, was 8 feet 4 inches. More remarkable still was the height of the child, Elizabeth Lyska, a Russian, who measured 6 feet 8 inches when 12 years of age. In the London Times of February 10, 1905, a description appeared of another giant, Machnow, a Russian, who was exhibited in London in his 28th year. He then stood 9 feet 8 inches, and weighed 360 pounds.

### The Russian Soldier.



Scott Liddell, who was with the Russian Medical Corps during the retreat through Poland, and was the only English-speaking man in Warsaw when that city fell, writes:—"Individually the Russian soldier is the finest soldier in the world. Whenever he spoke to a Russian officer about the physical strength of the men, he received the same answer—"Ah, you ought to have seen this regiment at the beginning of the war.
