WEIGHTS AND MEASURES.

Traders, Manufacturers and owners of Weights and Measures and Weighing Machines generally are hereby requested to read carefully the following instructions and act accordingly.

1. The Weights and Measures Act provides for a regular municipal inspection of all Weights and Measures used for trade purposes, as well as for irregular inspections of the same, which may be made at any time when deemed necessary by the Inspector, and it also imposes a heavy penalty on any trader or other person who wilfully obstructs or impedes an inspector or assistant inspector in the performance of his duty under said Act, or who refuses to produce or allow the whole of his weights and measures for inspection when called on to do so.

to any person, manufacturer or owner of weights, measures, and weighing machines who is required to obtain a certificate of Weights and Measures for verification of the same. The fee for such certificate is paid to the official certificate printer, and is received from the officer who makes the inspection. The official certificate is Form O-1, and is issued by the official certificate printer. It is thereupon properly filled out and stamped, and attached to the same time to carefully ascertain whether or not the stamps attached to such certificate represent exactly the value, the amount of weight, or the capacity of the measure. The official certificates of verification are of no value when the stamps attached to them are not properly charged are attached.

When the official certificate of verification is issued, the official certificate printer is especially required to keep them on file for two years, and in order to be available to them in their places of business in the manner required by law, it is necessary that the certificate for it must be distinctly understood that all traders, who are required to obtain such certificate, when asked to do so, by an inspector or assistant inspector, may, in all proper cases, have to pay over said fee.
