



Orders. The rates of commission on Money Orders issued by any Money Order Office in Newfoundland to the United States of America, the Dominion of Ganada and any part of Newfoundland, are as follows:

For sums not exceeding \$10 - 5 cts Over \$10 but not exceeding \$20 - 10 cts Over \$20 but not exceeding \$30 - 15 cts over \$80 but not exceeding \$40 - 20 ets Over \$40 but not exceeding \$50 - 25 ets Over \$50 but not exceeding \$60 - 30 cts Over \$60 but not exceeding \$70 - 35 cts Over \$70 but not exceeding \$80 - 40 cts Over \$80 but not exceeding \$90 - 45 ets Over \$90 but not exceeding \$100 50 2s Maximum amount of a single Order to any of the above countries and at affices in Newfoundland, \$100, but as many may be obtained as the remitter requires.
