STRIKERS RESORT TO THE USE OF BOMBS IN PARIS GARAGES

Companies Refuse to Accept Terms of Chauffeurs and Outrages Ensnare—Two Officials are Injured. Paris, Feb. 22.—A number of dynamite bombs were exploded by strikers today in the garages of the Taximeter Cab Companies which have not accepted the terms of the strikers. Many cars were burned and otherwise damaged. One of the bombs was picked up by the police and was being carried to the municipal laboratory when it exploded severely injuring two officials.

WOMAN SUSTAINS SEVERE INJURIES Falls into Railway Culvert and is Badly Hurt—Living in Extremely Reduced Circumstances.

Hampton, Kings Co., Feb. 22.—A woman known as Annie Lester, but who calls herself Annie Claine, living in a small house a short distance below Hampton Station, while walking on the track of the St. Martins Railway, on Tuesday evening, stepped into a culvert and in her fall sustained very serious injuries which for a time were thought would prove fatal. Apart from the shock and possibly internal troubles, she received a bad wound which caused the loss of a great deal of blood. She was attended by Dr. Weimore and is now somewhat better. She has been accustomed to go out washing and scrubbing to support her small family, but the accident has disclosed the fact that they are in reduced circumstances, the barest of furniture and an empty larder showing how much they need sympathy and aid. Niagara Falls, Feb. 22.—The Carnegie hero commission will be asked to give a medal to the family of Burrell Heacock in recognition of his brave attempt to save the lives of Mr. and Mrs. Elbridge Staunton, of Toronto when the ice bridge moved out. John Nelles, purchasing agent of the Lake Shore Railway, Cleveland, in whose office the boy was employed, has taken the matter up.

BUILDING OF THE VALLEY RAILWAY

Contracts Will be Let in de of Three Weeks—Gibson and Minto Railway—A. E. Trites May Build It. Fredericton, Feb. 22.—That the first of the contracts for the St. John Valley railway will be let by the St. John and Quebec Railway Company before the provincial legislature opens on March 7th, was the interesting announcement made last evening by Mr. Ross Thompson, the chief engineer. When asked as to whether one construction company would take the contract for the entire line and then sub-let parts of it to contractors, Mr. Thompson declined to talk. The St. John and Quebec Railway Company will move into large office quarters within a month or two. Mr. Thompson said last evening that the company might occupy the Torrens building on Queen street, which is to be sold under mortgage next month, and is likely to be bid in by parties who would lease it to the Railway company. "The St. John and Quebec Railway Company is not buying any real estate," Mr. Thompson is denying a report that the Railway company would become owners of the Torrens property.

It is understood that the plans are about completed and arrangements for the incorporation of the St. John and Grand Lake Coal and Railway Company to enter into a contract for the construction of the Gibson and Minto Railway, A. E. Trites, the well known railway contractor, arrived from Salisbury last evening and is at the Barker House. Mr. Trites it is understood, is likely to accept the contract for the construction of the road.

Notice appears in the Royal Gazette of the application for incorporation of the Atlantic Dredging & Construction Co., Ltd. Those applying for incorporation are Richard O'Leary, Richibucto; F. W. Sumner, Moncton; Thomas Steele, St. John, and Frederick Ryan, Sackville. The capitalization of the company will be \$250,000, and the head offices will be at Logzville, Northumberland county. This is the company which bought out the Messrs. Leslie's dredging plant.

Application is also made for the incorporation of the Coldbrook Realty and Development Co., Ltd. Those applying for incorporation are Henry Albert, Richibucto; W. Bowler, M. P., Sussex; William G. Fugeler, Montreal; James Robinson, Millerton, and Frank B. Carvell, M. P., Woodstock. The authorized capitalization of the company is to be \$40,000, and the company proposes to carry on a general realty and development business with the head office at Coldbrook.

Application will also be made today for the incorporation of the Gloucester Light and Power Company. The applicants for incorporation are John Robertson, Albert T. Hinton, George Robertson, William G. White, A. J. H. Stewart and George Windsor, all of Bathurst. The capitalization of the company is to be \$20,000, and the object is to furnish electricity for light, heat and power at Bathurst and elsewhere in Gloucester county.
