

MINUTES
OF THE
SYNOD OF HAMILTON AND LONDON,
OF
THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CANADA,
HELD IN CHATHAM,
APRIL 25TH, 26TH, AND 27TH, 1887.

At Chatham, and within Saint Andrew's Church there, the twenty-fifth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven years, at half past seven o'clock p. m., which day and place the Synod of Hamilton and London of the Presbyterian Church in Canada met, and after sermon from the retiring Moderator, the Rev'd George Burson, of St. Catharines, from St. John's Gospel, twentieth chapter and 20th verse; was duly constituted by prayer.

The Clerk then read the following roll of all the Ministers within the bounds with their Elders, as attested by the Presbytery Clerks.
