

Curing or Husbanding of Fish, shall be
or before the said Twenty fifth day of
March, Brinquish,quit and Leave, to
the publick use of the Fishing Ships
Arriving there, all and every the said
Stages, Cook-Rooms, Beeches and other
Places, for taking Bait and fishing,
and for the Drying, Curing and Husband-
ing of Fish.

And for the Preventing the Intrud-
ing and Detaining of all such Stages,
Cook-Rooms, Beeches, and other Places,
by any Person or Persons for the time to
come, Be it Enacted by the Authority
aforesaid, That no fisherman or Inha-
bitant in Newfoundland, or any other
Person or Persons whatsoever, shall, at
any time after the said Twenty fifth
Day of March, Seize, Take up or Pos-
sess any of the Stages, Cook-Rooms,
Beeches, or other Places which, at a-
ny time since the said year of our Lord,
One thousand six hundred eighty five,
did (or at any time hereafter shall be-
long to any Fishing Ship or Ships)
for taking Bait or fishing, or for Drying,
Curing or Husbanding of Fish, before
the Arrival of the Fishing Ships out of
England, Wales and Berwick, and until all
such Ships shall be provided with Sta-
ges, Cook-Rooms, Beeches, and other
Places, for taking Bait and fishing,
and for Drying, Curing and Husband-
ing of Fish.
