

Educational Calendar for Upper Canada.

Constructed from the School Laws and Regulations.

I. FIXED DATES.

JANUARY	1	The School Year begins. A statutory holiday (<i>Circumcision</i> .)
"	First	<i>Monday</i> : First Quarterly Examination at Toronto of candidates for masterships in Grammar Schools.
"	6	A statutory holiday in the Education Office (<i>Eptphany</i> .)
"	7	Winter term in the County Grammar Schools begins.
"	8	Winter Session of the Normal School begins
"	Second	<i>Wednesday</i> : Annual school elections throughout Upper Canada, of which six days previous notice must be given in three public places of each section, ward, &c. Within twenty days after meeting, election complaints can be investigated, and set aside or confirmed by the Local Superintendent in townships, and by a County Judge in cities, towns, and incorporated villages.
"	15	Grammar School Annual Report to be sent to the Chief Superintendent, by the Board of Trustees.
"	—	Common and Roman Catholic Separate School Annual Reports to be sent to the Chief Superintendent by the respective Boards of Trustees in cities, towns, and villages. An abstract of the report is to be published in one or more local newspapers.
"	30	Chief Superintendent's Annual Financial Report to Board of Audit.
"	31	School Section Annual Report to be sent to the Local Superintendent by the Trustees, who, after the 31st, are liable to a fine of five dollars for every week the report is delayed.
"	—	Two Grammar School Trustees to retire annually from the board on this day, and their places to be filled up by the County Council at their first meeting after the 1st of January.
FEBRUARY	First	<i>Wednesday</i> : the Board of Grammar School Trustees to meet annually on this day.
"	Last	<i>day</i> : Annual Financial Report of each Sub-Treasurer to be made up and transmitted, with vouchers, to the County Auditors.
MARCH	1	County, city, town, and village clerks to transmit to the Chief Superintendent the Auditors' account of school moneys, and other information.
"	—	Supporters of B. C. Separate Schools to give annual notice in writing to, and receive certificate from, clerk of municipality in which separate school is situated, of such support, on or before this day.
"	—	Local Superintendents to transmit their annual reports to the Chief Superintendent.
"	25	A statutory holiday in the Education Office (<i>Annunciation</i>)
"	—	Annual subscriptions of four dollars to the superannuated common school teachers fund, due in January, and to be transmitted as early in the year as possible. Should the subscription not be forwarded during the year, the sum of five dollars must be forwarded.
GOOD FRIDAY	<i>Good Friday</i> is a holiday in the County Grammar and Common Schools and in the Education Office.
EASTER	In March or April occurs the <i>Easter</i> vacation in the County Grammar and Common Schools. The Spring Term in the Grammar Schools commences on the first Wednesday after <i>Easter</i> .
APRIL	1	Termination of Local Superintendent's annual period of office; after which the new, or re-appointments will have to be reported to the Chief Superintendent by the County Clerk, or by the Board of Trustees in cities, towns, and villages.
MAY	1	Apportionment to Grammar and Common Schools to be notified by the Chief Superintendent.
"	9	<i>Moveable</i> : A statutory holiday in the Education Office (<i>Ascension</i> .)
"	24	<i>Queen's birthday</i> . a holiday in the County Grammar Schools and in the Education Office.
JUNE	10	<i>Moveable</i> : A statutory holiday in the Education Office (<i>Corpus Christi</i> .)
"	15	Normal School Winter Session ends.
"	Last	<i>Friday</i> : County Grammar School Spring Term ends with half-yearly examinations.
"	29	A statutory holiday in the Education Office (<i>St. Peter and St. Paul</i> .)
"	30	Half-yearly returns to be sent by the Trustees of Grammar (and Roman Catholic Separate) Schools to the Chief Superintendent, and by the Trustees of Rural Sections to the Local Superintendents.
"	—	Clerks of counties, cities, towns, and villages, to report the name of the Treasurer to the Chief Superintendent.
