## An Act to incorporate the Quebec and Lake Huron Railway Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it Preamble. be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and 5 House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :---

- 15 2. The persons named in section 1 of this Act are constitut- Provisional directors of the Company.

8. The capital stock of the Company shall be ten million Capital stock. dollars, and may be called up by the directors from time to time as they deem necessary, but no one shall exceed ten per 20 cent on the shares subscribed.

4. The head office of the Company shall be in the city of Head office. Quebec.

5. The annual meeting of the shareholders shall be held on Annual meeting.

25 6. At such meeting the subscribers for the capital stock Election of assembled, who have paid all calls due on their shares, shall directors. choose nine persons to be directors of the Company, one or more of whom may be paid directors.

7. The Company may lay out, construct and operate a rail-Line of 80 way of the gauge of four feet eight and one-half inches from a described, point in or near the city of Quebec to a point at or near the mouth of French River, on the Georgian Bay, following as much as possible a straight line between those two points, crossing the River St. Maurice at or near Grandes Piles, pass-85 ing near the village of St. Michel des Saints on the River

Matawin, crossing the river du Lièvre at or near Rapide de l'Orignal, the river Gatineau in the vicinity of the village of
