Duties of Trustees. **3.** The three trustees so clected shall form a committee for the administration of the secular affairs of their respective congregations, for the leasing of the pews and sittings in their respective churches, and for receiving themonies arising therefrom, and the other revenues of the congregation, and may recover the same in the name of the Corporation. 5 They shall continue as heretofore to manage the property, real and personal, belonging to their respective congregations, and retain all powers with regard to the same which they have heretofore enjoyed, subject always to the by-laws and regulations of the Corporation.

Joint Board, its powers and duties. 4. The said trustees for the two congregations together shall form 10 a joint Board for the transaction of the general business of the Corporation, and for the management of the joint property of the congregations, and they shall make an annual report thereon to the Corporation at a general meeting thereof, to be held annually on the day of , to receive the same, and for the transaction of all 15 business appertaining to the general management and interests of the

business appertaining to the general management and interests of the corporation.

Solemnization of Marriage, &c. 5. From and after the passing of this Act, the provisions of chapter twenty of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, respecting marriages, baptisms and burials, shall apply to the congregations in-20 corporated by this Act, and the ministers thereof may validly solemnize marriages, and may obtain and keep registers under the said Act, subject to the requirements, penalties and provisions thereof.

Corporation may unite with another denomination.

6. The said corporation may, by a vote of not less than three-fourths of its male members, pass a resolution declaring the connexion of the 25 said corporation with the United Presbyterian Church of North America terminated, and that they have connected themselves with any other branch of the Presbyterian denomination, and any such change shall be valid, and shall not affect their rights or powers under this Act, and they shall have power in such case to change their corporate name. 30

Public Act. 7. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
