Edmonton, Alberta	24 Apr./44	Monday	<p>The ensign hoisting ceremony was held this morning in front of the Normal School instead of on the parade ground. It took the form of an additional ceremony at which Mr. Ray Staples, City Chairman of the Victory Loan Committee, officially presented the Station with the Victory Loan pennant. To win this special banner it is required that a Station reach its objective and have a minimum of 75% of its personnel subscribe.</p> <p>This was the first Victory Banner to be presented, and it is significant that the presentation took place at 0815 hours of the opening day of the campaign.</p> <p>With an objective of \$50,000 the Station has already subscribed \$68,500, with 80.5% of the personnel participating.</p> <p>In the evening the entire Station, plus PAED and WETP units participated with other services in a big Victory Loan Parade in down-town Edmonton.</p> <p>S/O C. L. Fergusson (V.30178) (Eq. Messing) reported to the Station today on temporary duty.</p> <p>The Station's total in the Loan Campaign has now reached an even \$70,000, which is 40% in excess of the objective.</p> <p>Today 56 trainees, including 10 Senior NCOs, commenced training in Course #103. They were addressed early in the day by the Commanding Officer and the C.G.I.</p>	
	25 Apr./44	Tuesday	<p>R.149548, FS Beeching, C. P. (Carp. W&B) posted here on temporary duty to take charge of the W&B Section following the posting of F/O E. L. Burgess, W&B Engineer.</p> <p>Loan total has now reached \$71,950.</p>	
	26 Apr./44	Wednesday	<p>Commanding Officer's Parade and Inspection at 0800 hours, at which all Squadrons and Flights within Squadrons were formed up according to their respective standings in the Loan Campaign.</p> <p>The following officers were visitors on the Station today:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">S/L H.
